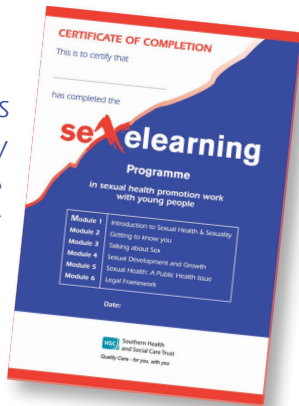


Timescale for Completion

Learners are advised that this programme will take approximately 6-8 hours to complete. It is advisable to set aside an hour per week to complete each module and aim to have the course completed within 8 weeks.

Certificate of Completion
