## MHFI Director of Operations: Summary of Work Undertaken in May 2015

Tasks included ...

- Coordinating requests for, and the distribution of, hard copies of the Men's Health Week (MHW) posters and postcards throughout Ireland.
- Creating, and online dissemination of, a paper on 'What can I do to mark Men's Health Week 2015'.
- Arranging for the design and creation of MHW 2015 graphics (banners, badges etc.) for the MHFI website.

- Fielding requests from media outlets for MHW quotes, interviewees, events listings etc.
- Responding to MHW queries from community groups looking for signposting to information, funding, support, partners, speakers ...
- Contributing to a South Eastern Health and Social Care Trust Men's Network planning meeting for MHW 2015 (Wednesday 27<sup>th</sup> May).
- Setting-up a battery of Goggle Alerts to track online coverage of MHW 2015.
- Creating and regularly updating the online MHW 2015 events list.
- Liaising with Health Minister Leo Varadkar's Media Advisor about the photo-call to launch MHW 2015.
- Contributing to an Engaging Young Men Project (EYMP) Unit 6 Planning Group teleconference (Friday 29<sup>th</sup> May), and writing minutes of this discussion.
- Continuing to liaise with Teach Bhride (Tullow, Co. Carlow), about arrangements for the EYMP Unit 6 training residential.
- Recruiting additional participants for the EYMP Training for Trainers programme.
- Making all practical arrangements for meetings of the MHFI Management Committee and the EYMP Advisory Group (to be held in early June).
- Beginning negotiations with 'Look Good, Feel Better' to desk share in Carmichael House.
- Proofing the content of the draft Dads Direct briefing paper on 'The Importance of Fathers to Children's Outcomes'.
